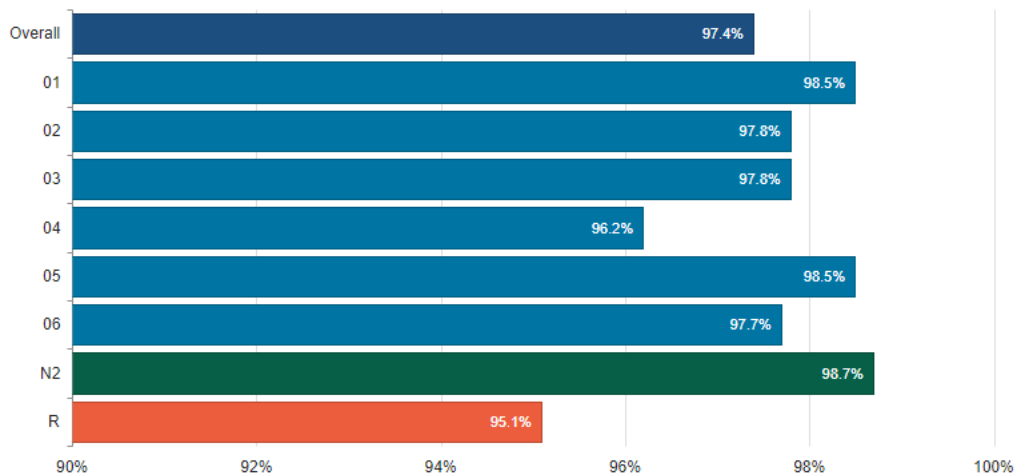

This week, we had a Special Educational Needs review carried out by 'Birmingham Education Partnership'. They were very complimentary about our provision for pupils with additional needs and the leadership and management of SEND carried out by Mrs Ray. Spending several hours in classrooms, they commented about how focussed and settled pupils were, how well staff know pupils in school and how pupils are supported to achieve the best outcomes they can.

They were especially complimentary about the mental health support offered to pupils in school from class teachers, teaching assistants and in particular, the pastoral team.

Miss Millington will start her after school club on Thursday 26th September. There will be **no club on the Thursday 3rd October** but the club will run every Thursday after that.

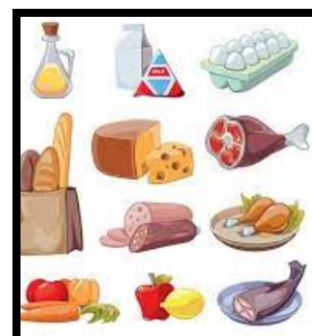

If there have been any changes to your child’s health 14 days before to the vaccination date YOU MUST contact the immunisation team on 0300 124 0366 as your child may not be well enough to receive the vaccination.
