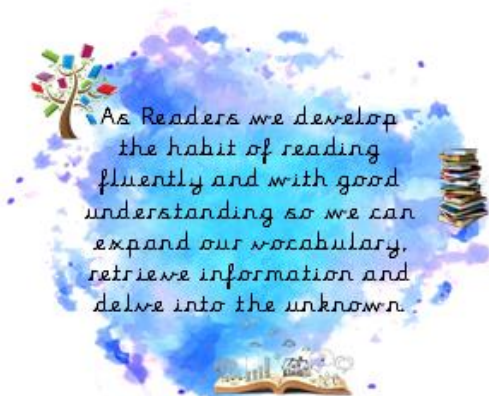

As Readers we develop the habit of reading fluently and with good understanding so we can expand our vocabulary, retrieve information and delve into the unknown.

Communication and language

Nursery children begin to form new friendships and relationships with staff and their peers.

Children will learn a new routine and begin to communicate their needs and wants.

In Talk 4 Writing, we will learn the song '1,2,3,4,5'.

In music, our theme this half term is 'Listen!'

Personal, social and emotional development

Through adult modelling and guidance, children will learn how to look after their bodies, including healthy eating and making healthy choices.

Physical Development

In PE, children are beginning to learn about their personal space to move around the hall safely. They are also learning to travel in different ways using control and show an awareness of others.

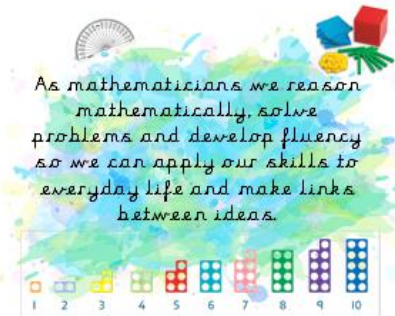
Children will experiment with a variety of fine motor activities to strengthen the muscles in their fingers, hands and arms.

Literacy

In literacy, children learn to listen and respond to stories. Children gain confidence in recognising sounds in the environment. Children begin to gain confidence in a group to adults and peers.



As mathematicians we reason mathematically, solve problems and develop fluency so we can apply our skills to everyday life and make links between ideas.

Mathematics

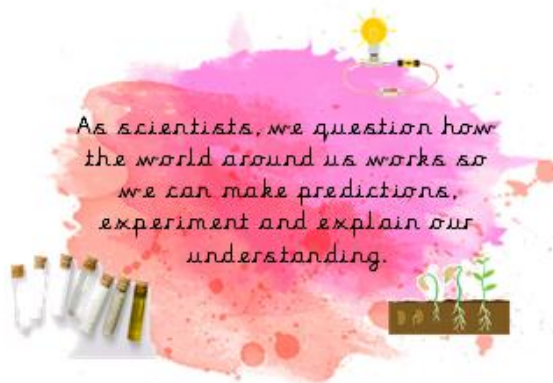
In maths, we will begin to explore simple composition of number through number rhymes. We will expose children to a variety of maths media by displaying numbers around the Nursery environment i.e. displays.

Children will know and sing a selection of number rhymes.

We will also teach the children the following skills
Numbers to 5

Practise counting aloud to 5.

Show 'finger numbers' to three



As scientists, we question how the world around us works so we can make predictions, experiment and explain our understanding.

Understanding the World

Children are learning to recognise that people have different beliefs and celebrate special events in different way. They are starting to recognise that other countries celebrate in different ways. The children will use their senses in hands on exploration of natural materials. The children will explore the forest school area and we will begin to talk about changing seasons and the differences in the environment



As artists, we experiment with techniques and media, so we can create artwork that reflects ourselves and the world around us.

Expressive Art and Design

Children will begin to explore a variety of art equipment in Nursery. Children will paint, draw and create using their own ideas.

Children will be able to access the creative trolley to make choices about what they would like to create. We will use and explore a variety of materials and begin to weave using large outdoor shapes and ribbons.

During role play, children will begin to use their own experiences to develop storylines.

During music sessions children will begin to copy actions and simple dance routines.



As individuals, we appreciate the religions and beliefs of all so we can demonstrate mutual respect and tolerance in a diverse society.

Children will show an interest in different occupations and people who help us.

During Jigsaw sessions (linked to PSED) children will explore more about relationships with their peers and the important people in their lives.
