Communication and language

Children are learning what a question is and how questions can be used to find out more information.

Through whole class reading texts children will be introduced to increase new vocabulary.

Children are beginning to understand how to listen carefully to gain knowledge and understanding.

Linking to the whole school who use Talk 4 Writing we will learn the song Incy, Wincy Spider.

Through our Music scheme our theme this half term is Me!



Personal, social and emotional development

In PSED, children are learning about their feelings and how events/scenarios can trigger certain emotions. Children are learning how to construct respectful relationships with their peers and build positive friendships.

Physical Development

In PE, children are beginning to learn about their personal space to move around the hall safely. They are also learning to travel in different ways using control and show an awareness of others.

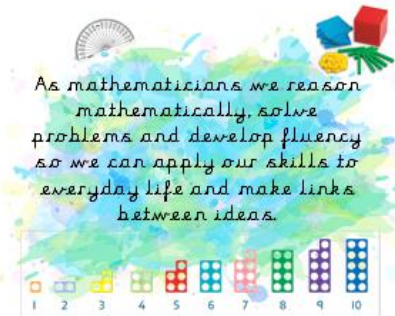
Children will experiment with a variety of fine motor activities to strengthen the muscles in their fingers, hands and arms.



As Writers we communicate clearly, accurately and coherently so we can purposefully express ourselves to a range of audiences.

Literacy

In literacy, children begin to learn set one sounds from RWI. Children gain confidence saying these sounds correctly and talking in a group to adults and peers.



As mathematicians we reason mathematically, solve problems and develop fluency so we can apply our skills to everyday life and make links between ideas.

Mathematics

In maths, children will explore 2D shapes and begin to recognise numbers 1-3 touch counting these amounts accurately and collecting the correct amount from a larger set.

The children will extend and create ABAB patterns and begin to notice errors in a repeating pattern.



As scientists, we question how the world around us works so we can make predictions, experiment and explain our understanding.

Understanding the World

Children are learning to recognise that people have different beliefs and celebrate special events in different way. They are starting to recognise that other countries celebrate in different ways.

The children will use their senses in hands on exploration of natural materials. The children will explore the forest school area and we will begin to talk about changing seasons and the differences in the environment.



Expressive Art and Design

Children will learn new songs for their Christmas performance and perform the play as a group to an audience. Children will explore a variety of different media to create different types of artwork and will participate in gross motor art activities such as splatter painting.

Children will look at important people in various religions such as Christianity and Hinduism. Children will learn about the Nativity Story and understand what the meaning of Christmas is.
