

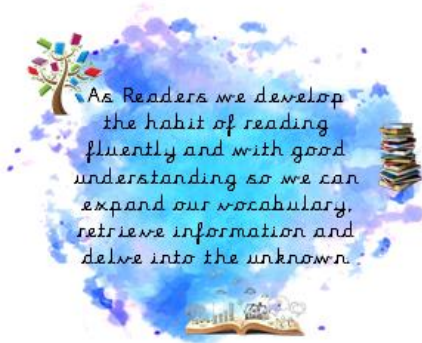

Reading -

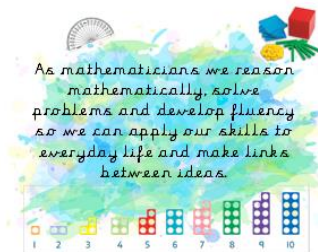
In RWI lessons, pupils develop their decoding and reading skills to develop fluency. In Whole Class Reading, our focus is comprehension and we will be doing this through the use of past SATs papers. Children apply their retrieval, inference and summary skills to answer questions about what they have read.



Writing –

The children in Miss Millington’s phonics group will be starting Talk for Writing. This is where we use a model text, learn the text off by heart and dissect it. We then take the key skills and rewrite the story ourselves.



The other groups follow the RWI scheme and children produce writing based on their weekly book. These include a range of fiction and non-fiction texts. Children have daily grammar activities to build their knowledge of key terminology and apply this to their writing. Children produce persuasive texts, stories and information texts.



Mathematics –

In maths, we will be covering money and multiplication and division. In money we will be learning about pounds, pence, notes and change. In multiplication and division we will focus on the 2s, 5s and 10 times tables.

Throughout the week, we will be using class clocks to help children become familiar with telling the time. (half past, o’clock, quarter to and past)

 <p><i>As scientists, we question how the world around us works so we can make predictions, experiment and explain our understanding.</i></p>	<p>Science - Plants</p> <p>In science, we will be learning about plants. We will be learning what they need to be able to grow and the parts of the plant. We will be growing our own seeds so that we can observe how they grow into mature plants.</p>
 <p><i>As artists, we experiment with techniques and media, so we can create artwork that reflects ourselves and the world around us.</i></p>	<p>Art – Illustrators</p> <p>In art, we will be looking at illustrators that produce famous children’s books. We will be looking at Roger Hargreaves who created the Mr Men books and Antony Browne. We will also look at Nick Park who created Wallace and Gromit.</p>
 <p><i>As geographers, we explore the world we live in so we can question and understand the interaction between our planet and its people.</i></p>	<p>Geography – Where are we?</p> <p>In Geography, we will be exploring where we are in the world. We will be looking at the four countries of the UK along with its physical and human features. We will be comparing this to Tulum in Mexico. We will also learn about the continents and the oceans. We will be using Google Maps, atlases, globes, satellite images and compass directions.</p>
 <p><i>As musicians, we express ourselves and appreciate the work of others so we can compose, practise and perform with enjoyment.</i></p>	<p>Music – Charanga</p> <p>In music, we will be learning the song ‘I Wanna be in a Band’. The children will listen and appraise the song, learn about singing together and how to be in an ensemble. As well as learning to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song, children will listen and appraise classic Rock songs.</p>
 <p><i>As individuals, we appreciate the religions and beliefs of all so we can demonstrate mutual respect and tolerance in a diverse society.</i></p>	<p>RE – Islam</p> <p>In RE, we will be studying Islam. We will be learning about why they pray five times a day and why this is so important. We will be looking at what ‘commitment’ means to Muslims.</p>



As aspiring athletes, we are physically active so we can lead healthy lives and develop skills in a variety of activities. We compete fairly, both individually and within teams. We aim to win but we can accept defeat graciously.



PE – Dance and Games

In dance, we will be exploring dances from around the world linking to our Geography topics. The children will learn a dance from different places in the UK and around the world.



As citizens, we recognise and understand our own and others' needs, so we can make informed choices about our wellbeing.

PSHE – Healthy Me

In PSHE, we will be learning about how to keep ourselves healthy. We will look at what we put into our bodies and how this effects us and also, how we can look after our mental health. We will look at the food groups and the impact they have on our body.



As computer scientists, we develop our use of digital systems so we can responsibly programme, create and communicate using a range of technology.

Computing – Importing and editing

In computing, pupils will be learning to use Word to develop their typing, copying, pasting and keyboard skills. Pupils will learn how to import an image into a word document and children will learn how to create a digital piece of writing.
