

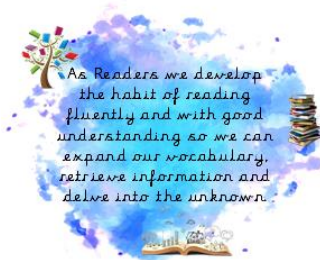

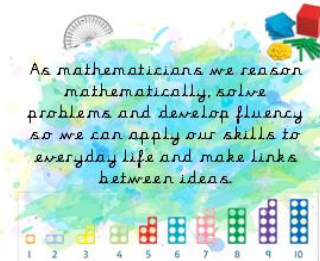
As Readers we develop the habit of reading fluently and with good understanding so we can expand our vocabulary, retrieve information and delve into the unknown.

Reading – In Summer 2, we will be reading ‘Fantastic Mr Fox’ by Roald Dahl. We will be focusing on the VIPERS skills and practicing how to use these in SATs style questions, using our inference skills to find information in the text. We will also be predicting endings and creating alternative endings.



As Writers we communicate clearly, accurately and coherently so we can purposefully express ourselves to a range of audiences.

Writing – In Talk for Writing the children will be writing their own innovated stories based on a model text. They will be learning a model text off by heart, making up actions for the text, then innovating the story to make in their own through careful planning and understanding of success criteria.



As mathematicians we reason mathematically, solve problems and develop fluency so we can apply our skills to everyday life and make links between ideas.



Mathematics –

In Maths we will be focusing on shape, space and measure. We will be recapping the names of shapes and their properties. We will be looking at position and direction and also symmetry. The children will practice how to find half and a quarter of shapes.



As artists, we experiment with techniques and media, so we can create artwork that reflects ourselves and the world around us.

Art –

In art we will be looking at perspective. We will be discussing how things in the background are smaller and things in the foreground are larger. We will be sketching pictures of Blackpool, showing perspective.



As geographers, we explore the world we live in so we can question and understand the interaction between our planet and its people.

Geography – In Geography we will visit Blackpool. As part of this trip we will compare our local area to Blackpool and see what is the same and what is different. We will focus on human and physical features and see how they differ. We will also



As historians, we learn from the past so we can understand changes over time and how this can impact on our own lives.

History – In History we will study Significant Women. We will explore the lives of Mary Seacole and Florence Nightingale and the impact that they had on society. We will then compare the women and how they have effected how we live our lives today.



As Designers we plan, test and create so we can solve relevant problems to meet the needs of ourselves and those around us.

Design and Technology –

In D&T we will be looking at how to make a fruit salad. The children will be designing a fruit salad, thinking about which fruits go well together. They will also think about how easy each fruit is to cut. The children will be using knives to cut their fruit and choosing a juice to go with it.



As musicians, we express ourselves and appreciate the work of others so we can compose, practise and perform with enjoyment.

Music – In music we will be using the Charanga programme to ‘Rewind, Reflect and Replay’.

“This Unit of Work consolidates the learning that has occurred during the year. All the learning is focused around revisiting songs and musical activities, a context for the History of Music and the beginnings of the Language of Music.”



As aspiring athletes, we are physically active so we can lead healthy lives and develop skills in a variety of activities. We compete fairly, both individually and within teams. We aim to win but we can accept defeat graciously.

PE – Dance and Team Games

In indoor PE we will be doing dance. We will learn how to dance along to different songs chosen by the children. We will listen to different genres of music and decide which moves should go to which songs.

In outdoor PE we will be doing team games whereby the children practice their team building skills.



PSHE – In PSHE we will cover ‘Changing Me’. We will focus on how things are changing in our minds and in our bodies. We will discuss our feelings about these changes. We will also think about how people’s bodies change as they get older and how to differentiation between male and female bodies. We will also do the ‘One Goal’ programme.



Computing – In Computing we will be learning to send emails. This will consist of opening a word document to practice typing an email. Editing and upleveling the email and then sending it. We will send an email together in our classes to the school in Blackpool and ask for a reply.
