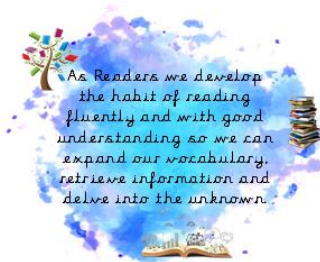

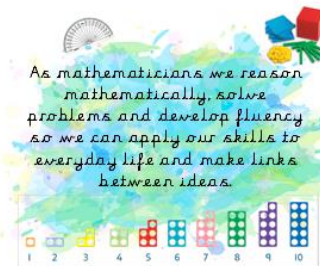
Reading –

In our whole class reading lessons we will be reading 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes. We will be using the VIPERS skills to interpret the story. We will focus on answering questions using each of the VIPERS and using our interpreting skills.



Writing -

In writing we will be writing our own non-chronological report about Woolly Mammoths. We will be learning all of the skills from Grammarsaurus including how to identify a subject and a verb, FANBOYS conjunctions and prepositions.



Mathematics –

In maths, we will be covering place value and addition and subtraction. During place value, we will be learning how to partition numbers, estimate on a number line and know the value of numbers. We will also be covering addition and subtraction, where we will be focusing on exchanging, crossing boundaries and adding/subtracting 3-digit by 2-digit numbers and 3-digit by 3-digit.



Science – Bones and Muscles

In science, we will be studying bones and muscles. We will cover things such as how muscles relax and contract, creating cardboard bones which shown how our muscles relax and contract. As well as this, we will be naming lots bones within the body and exploring why they are important.



History – Stone Age – Iron Age

In History, we will be covering the Stone Age. During this unit of work, the children will explore how the Stone Age transitions into the Iron Age. We will cover topics such as; Stone Age homes, what did stone age people wear? Differences between Stone Age and Iron Age homes and more.



Music -

In music we will be using Charanga to learn the song 'Let your Spirit Fly'. We will be learning the lyrics, using the xylophones alongside the music and also performing the song to an audience. We will be taking feedback on board and improving our performance.



RE – Sikhism

In RE, we will be studying Sikhism. The students will investigate key questions such as, 'Does joining Khalsa make a person a better Sikh' and 'Do Sikhs think it is important to share?'.



PE – Basketball.

In PE, we will be focusing on basketball. The students will practice there throwing, catching and shooting skills. We will also play basketball related games to enhance these skills.

PSHE – Being me in my world.

Computing – Networks

In computing, we will be looking at networks. During this unit of work, we will be focusing on what a network is and how it works. We will go round our school looking at what our networks are and why it is important.
