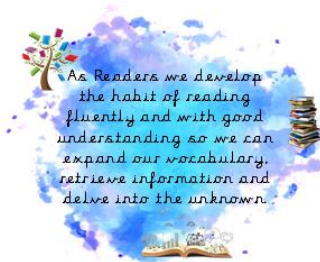

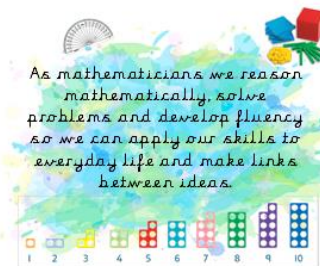
Reading

In Whole Class Reading, we will explore a story without words; The Arrival and the importance of illustrations in texts.



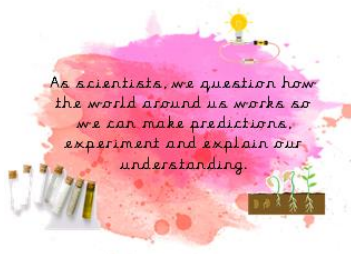
Writing

We will transfer our ideas into Design and Technology lessons to produce our dragon eye out of clay.</p>
 <p><i>As Designers we plan, test and create so we can solve relevant problems to meet the needs of ourselves and those around us.</i></p>	<p>Design and Technology – Dragon Eyes</p> <p>In Design and Technology, we will be sculpting our dragon eyes out of clay using a variety of tools. We will explore colour mixing to finalise our product.</p>
 <p><i>As linguists, we use a variety of skills and resources to communicate. We broaden our cultural horizons so we can communicate for practical purposes and develop an understanding of other cultures.</i></p>	<p>French - Conversations</p> <p>In French, we will be learning how to develop conversations with our peers using simple greetings, phrases and questions.</p>
 <p><i>As individuals, we appreciate the religions and beliefs of all so we can demonstrate mutual respect and tolerance in a diverse society.</i></p>	<p>RE – Life After Death</p> <p>In RE, we will be exploring the question ‘Does belief in Akhirah (life after death) help Muslims lead good lives?’</p> <p>We will recognise the importance of faith to others and how people show their faith in different ways.</p>
 <p><i>As aspiring athletes, we are physically active so we can lead healthy lives and develop skills in a variety of activities. We compete fairly, both individually and within teams. We aim to win but we can accept defeat graciously.</i></p>	<p>PE – Athletics</p> <p>During PE, we will compete as an individual and as a team in a competition.
