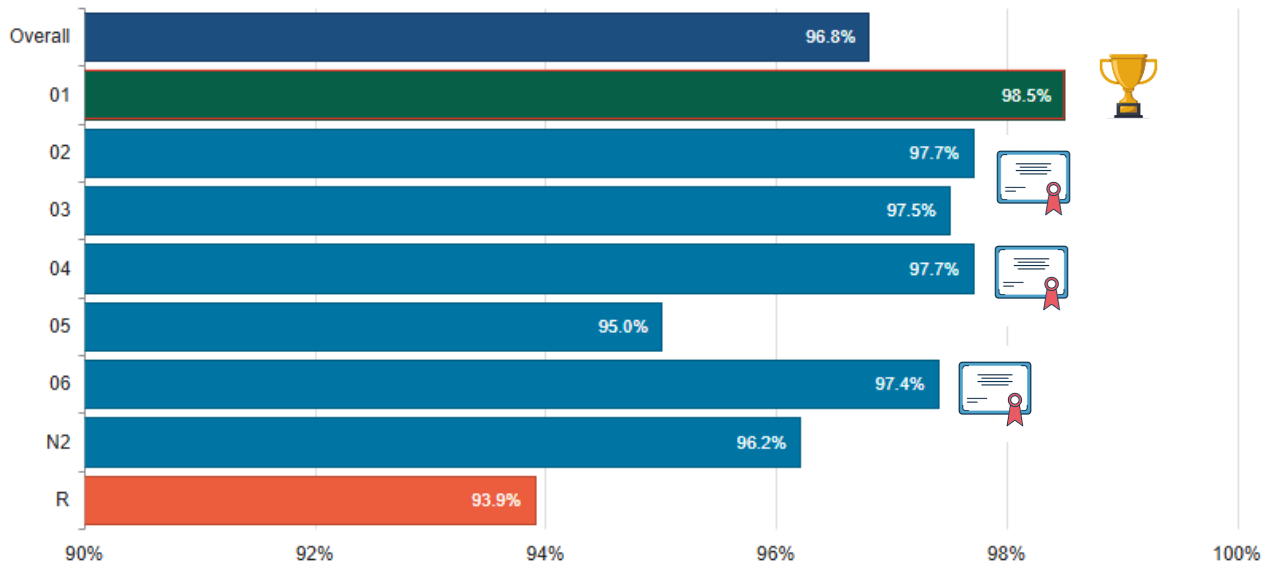

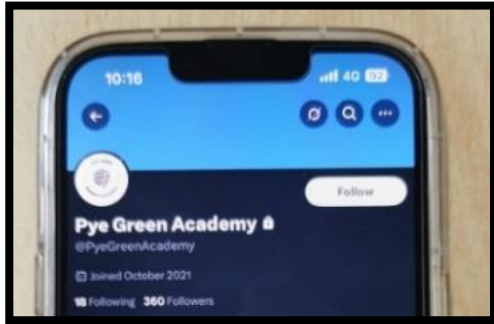

## Hot Weather – Sun Protection

Ensuring your child is protected from the sun while at school is very important.

Here are some tips for parents:

- Use a broad-spectrum **sunscreen** with an SPF of at least 30. Ideally a once-a-day application is best for school. If you do send suncream into school, you must complete a form which is available from the school office. It must be kept in the class teacher's cupboard and not in children's bags.
- Show your child how to apply sunscreen, covering all exposed areas like the face, ears, neck and hands. Have your child practice applying sunscreen at home so they become comfortable doing it. **Staff are not able to apply suncream to children.**
- Encourage your child to wear a hat with a wide brim and wear light clothing that covers as much skin as possible.
- We will advise children to seek **shade** during their time outdoors.
- Ensure your child brings a **water** bottle to school so they can stay hydrated. Please remind pupils these can be refilled throughout the day.
