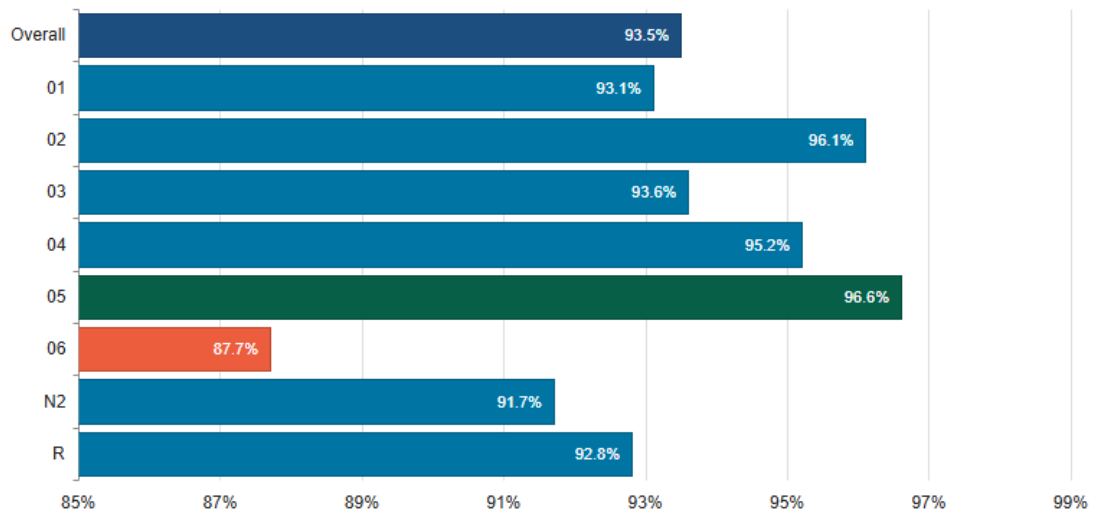

Let's make it a safe, fun and memorable weekend for all!



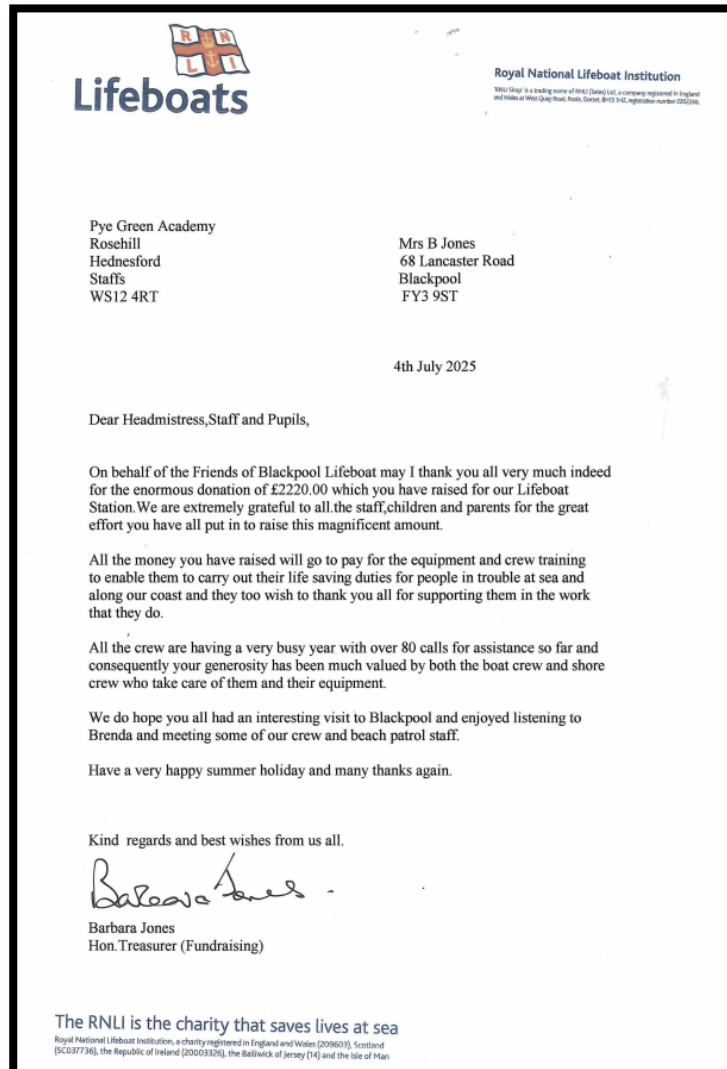
Pye Green Academy Swimming Statement

Here at Pye Green Academy, we take school swimming seriously. Swimming is not only a key life skill for pupils that allows them to be physically active and enjoy water-based activities, but also a lifesaving skill. With many lakes, rivers and canals surrounding the area in which we live, it is crucial that pupils know how to stay safe in and around the water.

We offer free school swimming lessons to all pupils in Year 4 and additional top up swimming sessions to pupils in Year 5.

In school, we also learn all about water safety. In Year 2, we learn about the RNLI, how to stay safe in water and what to do if we need help. Each year, we carry out fundraising activities for Blackpool RNLI and when we visit them in the summer term, they teach us about staying safe in water.

We appreciate the support and role parents can play in helping their children gain water confidence and awareness. We have attached some activities you can do at home with your children to prepare them for lessons and gain confidence. We have also attached some water safety learning activities that would be useful to look at with your child. It would be great if you could have a walk near water and discuss these practically with your children.
