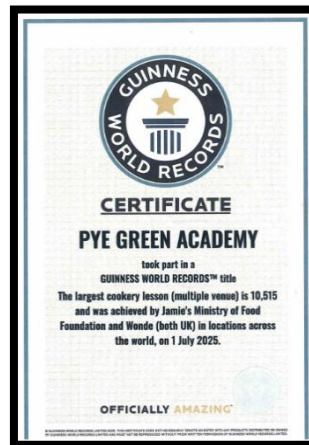

### Please Parking Considerately

We are continuing to receive numerous complaints from local residents about dangerous and inconsiderate parking. Many are concerned that due to the way some parents are parking, it is 'an accident waiting to happen'.

Please remember, it is against the law to:

- Park on yellow lines during specified times
- Park on school entrance markings

It is also advised not to park on pavements unless signs permit it and to park away from the crossing patrol so that the pedestrians view is not restricted.

Once again, we have requested the local traffic enforcement team visit our school regularly at drop off and collection times.



### Safe Driving

Please can we request that parents who are allowed to use the staff car park do so in a safe manner. We do have several cameras capturing the school car park which unfortunately are recording many dangerous events.

These include:

- Excessive speed
- Driving on the wrong side of the road
- Careless manoeuvring of vehicles
- Not parking in designated parking bays

This situation will be monitored over the coming weeks. If drivers continue to drive in a careless manner, they will be prevented from using the car park in order to protect other users.
